2-Conditions of entry, Entry restrictions

Conditions of Entry: Open to horses registered in the WAHO recognized studbook of Jordan (RJSB) by the closing date of entries April 30th,2025.

Restrictions of Entry: Horses with shaved tactile hair will be fined and will <u>not</u> be <u>allowed</u> to participate in the show.

Panda Eyes are not encouraged and horses with panda eyes will fined.

Panda eyes: Removal of normal hair around the eyes.

5-Method of Judging

Comparative judging

The Comparative judging system will be used with one judge judging the horses by comparing and ranking them.

Qualification system for Championships

Horses placed first and second in their respective classes qualify for the Championship.

Standard ECAHO method will be used (see 6 Rules for Championships).

7- Rules for Foal Classes

Foal Classes

In those shows where foal classes are held:

- a) Foals may not compete in EAHSC Championships, nor will they qualify for any future Title or A Show.
- b) When foal classes are organized at EAHSC affiliated shows, the EAHSC Rules will apply.
- c) Foals must have a minimum age of four weeks at the date of the show and must be shown at foot (with the dam) up to 6 months of age. Orphaned or rejected foals under six months cannot be shown.
- d) The use of metal halters and halters with metal chains is forbidden.
- e) A comparative judging system will be used.
- f) All the rules pertaining to foal classes must be clearly indicated in the schedule and the catalogue.

10. Equine Influenza vaccination for all horses competing in ECAHO competitions

- 1. All horses (except foals at foot of the dam and/or foals less than 9 months old) must have received an initial Primary Course of two vaccination doses administered a minimum of 21 and a maximum of 92 days apart. Foals should begin the primary course of vaccination at 6 months of age. It is under the owners' responsibility if they are shown before the primary course of vaccination is complete.

 Any horse receiving a new Primary Course as of 1st January 2024 must receive the second vaccination a minimum of 21 days and a maximum of 60 days after the first vaccination.
- 2. The First Booster must be given within 7 calendar months following the date of administration of the second vaccination of the primary course.

Horses which have received a correct primary course of vaccinations may arrive at an ECAHO event up to 6 months + 21 days months after the second dose of the primary course.

- 3. Horses that were correctly certified as receiving the primary course prior to 2009 are not required to fulfil the requirement of the first booster, providing there has been no lapse in their vaccination regime.
- 4. Further booster vaccinations must be given within 12 months of the last dose, or shorter intervals where local or national authorities require it. However, horses that are competing must have been vaccinated within 6 months +21 days of arriving at the Show an ECAHO event.

- 5. No vaccination may be given within 7 days of the day of arrival at the ECAHO event.
- 6. Vaccines must be administered by a veterinarian. The details of the vaccine, serial/batch number and the date of administration must be recorded in the passport, signed and stamped by the veterinarian who administered the vaccination.
- 7. The entering of vaccination details in a new passport or a duplicate: if the vaccination history of a horse is very long, the veterinarian may use the following statement "The vaccination history of this horse is correct to date (enter the last vaccination date)", signed and stamped by a veterinarian.

Sanctions for vaccination irregularities:

- a) regarding the 6 months + 21 days from last vaccination date:
 - Up to 1 week late:
 - o a fine of €130. The horse will be allowed to compete.
 - Between 1 and 2 weeks late:
 - o a fine of € 200. The horse will be allowed to compete.
 - More than 2 weeks late or Last vaccination within the last 7 days of arrival:
 - o a fine of € 280, the horse will not be allowed to compete and must leave the show ground as soon as possible.
- b) regarding incorrect, incomplete or missing Primary course, Incorrect or missing First booster

vaccination and/or Overdue yearly booster:

- where required: a fine of \in 280, the horse will not be allowed to compete and must leave the show ground as soon as possible. (The vaccinations must be restarted as in articles 1 and 2).
- 9. Repeat offenders of any minimum vaccination requirement contravention will be reported to the SDC for consideration of higher sanctions.

11- Regulations & General Conditions (including Closing Date, Entry Fees and Charges, Stabling, and Payment Details)

THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES IS: April 30Th, 2025

Late entries cannot be accepted after these dates. Entries and stable reservations must be made on the appropriate forms (or on photocopies of them), accompanied by Part 1 of the entry form. Please note, only one entry per form.

Horses will only be considered entered once the appropriate fees have been received, cheques have been cleared or confirmation of bank transfer has been received

Entry Fees and Charges

200 JDs for registration.

Stabling

The stables can be occupied from May 27th till June 1st, 2025.

Any horse occupying stables not allocated to it (thus preventing the use of the stable by the rightful occupant), will not be allowed to compete for the duration of the show!

Starting Order

The starting order will be decided randomly.

Exhibitors' facilities

Grooms' accommodation will be available at the showground.

Liability Disclaimer

The organisers shall not be liable for death, injury, disease or damage to any person, horse or property howsoever caused. It is furthermore an express condition of entry that exhibitors shall indemnify the organisers against all actions, costs, claims, demands or liability, whatsoever arising out of any action in which he or she may be concerned. The organisers reserve the right to make any changes to the show schedule or to cancel all arrangements at their discretion in the event of a force majeure.

No entry will be accepted until payment has been cleared or confirmation of bank transfer has been received. If payment fails to clear due to inadequate funds, then all costs incurred by organizer must be paid by the exhibitor. Failure to do so will result in future entries being refused.

General Conditions

- 1. The Show is governed by the 'Rules for Conduct of Shows' (2024) established by the European Arab Horse Show Commission. These rules will be applied in their entirety. The Show is organised by and under the rules of Royal Jordanian Equestrian Federation.
- 2. All horses must be free from infections and from a home stock free of epidemic diseases. They must be effectively vaccinated against Influenza and the Vaccination Certificate must be produced. Any horse may be quarantined at the discretion of the Disciplinary Committee Veterinarian.
- 3. No compensation for transportation costs will be granted.
- 4. (A staff list for access to the International Quarantine Stabling must be provided with the entry forms. Only persons that need to enter will be permitted to do so.)
- 5. The Organiser is not liable for damages and accidents to participants, grooms, audience, or fittings, nor are they liable for theft.
- 6. All stable equipment is to be provided by exhibitors or may be loaned, by prior arrangement, from the Organisers.

- 7. All the participating horses may be subjected to medication control at the request of the Disciplinary Committee.
- 8. All exhibitors will be expected to conduct themselves in the spirit of rules of ethical show behaviour and will be responsible for themselves, their handlers and grooms.
- 9. Exhibitor numbers will be distributed from the Show Office.
